It is a great pleasure to write in support of Ioan Andrei Cursaru, who I know as Andrei Cursaru. This is a general reference and recommendation supporting Andrei's application for an internship. I have known Andrei for one year.

I am an Associate Professor of Politics and International Studies at the University of Warwick, where I have been working for around twenty years. In my time at Warwick, I have held a wide variety of senior academic and administrative roles at department, faculty and university levels, as well as serving as external examiner at a number of leading UK universities. I have supervised seven PhD students to completion, six of whom are now working in academia whilst the seventh is working as a government official.

Andrei is known to me as one of my Masters students (2018-19 cohort), and as a research assistant on my current project analysing the politics of nuclear waste. As a student on my MA module on the Global Politics of Nuclear Weapons, Andrei took part in class discussions, delivered several very good individual research presentations, and wrote an excellent 5,000 word essay.
